Improving smallholder farmers' livelihoods and safeguarding forest ecosystems through promoting sustainable natural rubber production aligned with international market requirements in Lampung province.

Duration 2024–2026.

- Enable smallholder farmers to advance jointly with their supply chain partners to sustainable production systems and supply chains.
- 42,000 farmers to be mapped by 2026, deforestation and environmental degradation risks and HCV assessment.
- **2,000 farmers to be trained on GAP** and registered under STDB.
- **40 villages to be organised under farmer organisations. Business Partnerships** with RJL Factory and other processing factories.
- **Loyalty farmer programme**

Solidaridad

Support sustainable rubber production in compliance with international standards, while addressing livelihoods' needs of rubber-growing communities.

12 months, ended in dec 2025

- Strengthen compliance capacities of the natural rubber value chain (e.g., GPSNR, EUDR) in the Mé and Indénié-Djuablin regions. **79 cooperatives trained and 1000 producers onboarded with rubberwiki.**
- Raise awareness among rubber-growing communities on issues related to social inclusion and gender equality.
- Improve the knowledge of value chain stakeholders and the adoption of good agricultural practices – **2 green schools supported (50 tappers)**
- **Supported 615 women in rubber-growing communities in diversifying their livelihoods** through the establishment of alternative income-generating activities.
